A LITTLE HISTORY

The New Hamburg Yacht Club started as an iceboat club in 1869. (A second floor on stilts housed club meetings, with the boats stored underneath.) Sixty years later, the club looked like this:



Since then, we have closed the first floor in, bought adjacent property, and made major upgrades to the club, its grounds, and our docking facilities for sail, motor, and hand powered boats of many shapes and sizes.

Today the club is a friendly Hudson River home base to several hundred members and their families.

REGULAR ATTRACTIONS INCLUDE

- Monthly Sunday breakfasts during the summer.
- Special events that combine great music and food.
- Everyday opportunities to lounge or picnic on the river's banks.
- One of the lowest club membership costs on the Hudson.

MEMBERS CAN

- Put a boat on a club dock with water and electricity.
- Launch a boat from our ramp.
- Enjoy the club without ever getting a boat.
- Use our shower and toilet facilities.
- Rent part of the club for private functions.

MEMBERSHIP

- The club's constitution limits membership to 150 members.
- A one-time initiation fee is \$500.
- Annual dues are approximately \$275.
- Members with a dock pay a dock fee of \$250 per boat plus \$3.25 a foot.
- All members have a work hour commitment.
